Primary PE Funding

Intent for 2022/2023
PE and Sports Premium

Under the Primary PE and Sport funding initiative, in 2022/23 we will receive £18,700 to support PE and sport in our school. The impact of the funding must be considered in terms of these 5 key indicators:

- The engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity – the Chief Medical Officer guidelines recommend that all children and young people aged 5 to 18 engage in at least 60 minutes of physical activity a day, of which 30 minutes should be in school
- The profile of PE and sport is raised across the school as a tool for whole-school improvement
- Increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport
- Broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils
- Increased participation in competitive sport.



We propose to spend this money in the following ways:

Increased levels of fitness and activity.	£1,100
Greater engagement in physical activity amongst children.	
Greater structure to play activities in the playground.	
Raising the Profile of PE and sport across school	
Increased profile for PE and Sport around school.	£1,600
Increased engagement of whole school community in PE	
Increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport	
Greater variety of activities experienced within lessons.	£600
Level of challenge in PE sessions increased, especially for the more-able.	
More focussed development of key PE skills based on skills progression document.	
Support provided for children who might be struggling with aspects of PE.	
Broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils	
Develop opportunities to enhance provision in key areas in KS1 and KS2.	£8,200
Ensure coverage of key skills and sports across school.	
Continue to develop our adventurous activity offering across school.	
Increased participation in competitive sport	
Broaden opportunities for children to compete against other others and themselves in age appropriate, competitive sport.	£7,200
Increased levels of resilience and self-confidence	
Retain engagement amongst children
