- Simply sit in a comfy chair and read in front of a real fire.

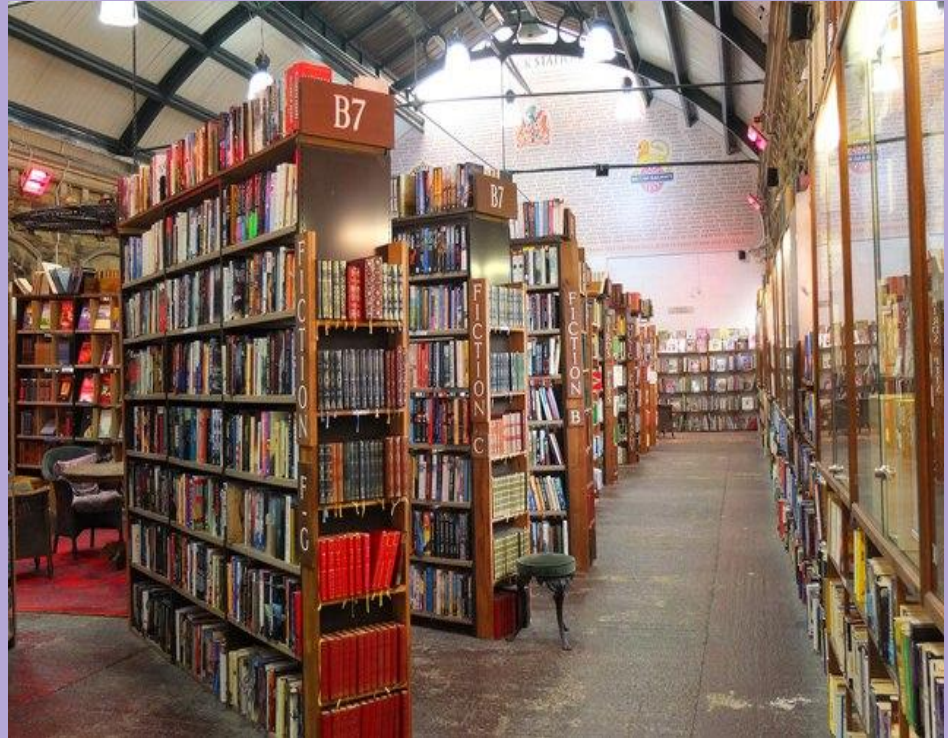


Why you should visit
