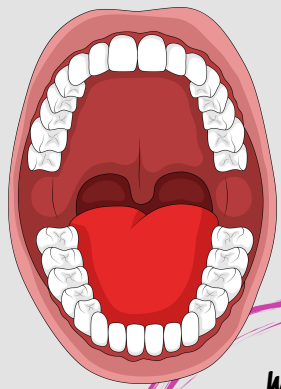

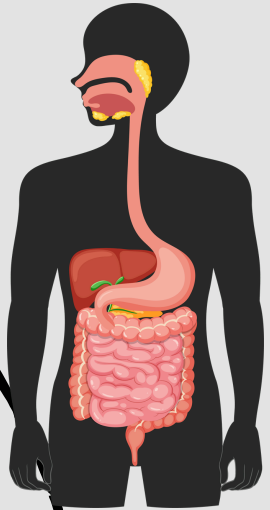

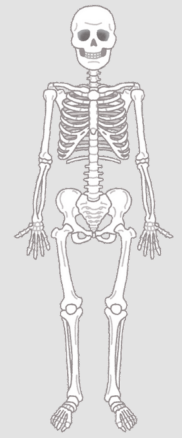
Prior Learning
