Here is today's little ditty to read together

Tricky word: *new* *blossom*



The sun is up and I am in **my**
garden.

I can see a brand new green
leaf. It feels soft and **I like to**
rub it. **I** can see blossom too.

The blossom is pink. **Do you**
like it?

Notes to parents: I don't expect the children to be able to read the tricky words straight away but if you've looked at them together before you start to read, the children should be able to get them in context. Once you've read a few times you can have a go at writing today's 'hold a sentence'...

The leaf feels soft.

For today's extension sentence – get your child to look out of the window to see what they can see outside or in their garden. Pop this into a sentence "I can see..."

When writing, don't forget to encourage the children to use their neat writing, leave finger spaces and sound out their words. Happy reading and writing to you all!
