AMAZING!!!!

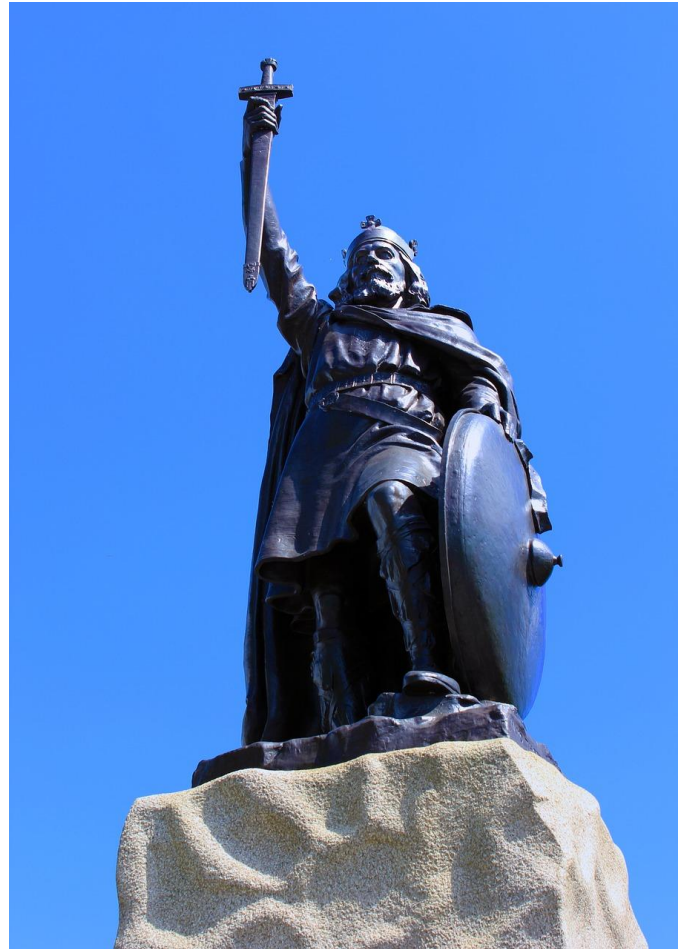


When did he die
