In our History lessons we are going to investigate what life was like during the 17th century, what was important to the people and what laws were made that are still used today.


Have a little think about:

#### Decimals and Percentages

For those of you in Year 5, we will be introducing percentages (%) and exploring the way 'percent' relates to the number of parts per 100. We will then make connections to our recent work on fractions and decimals.

#### Area and Perimeter
