

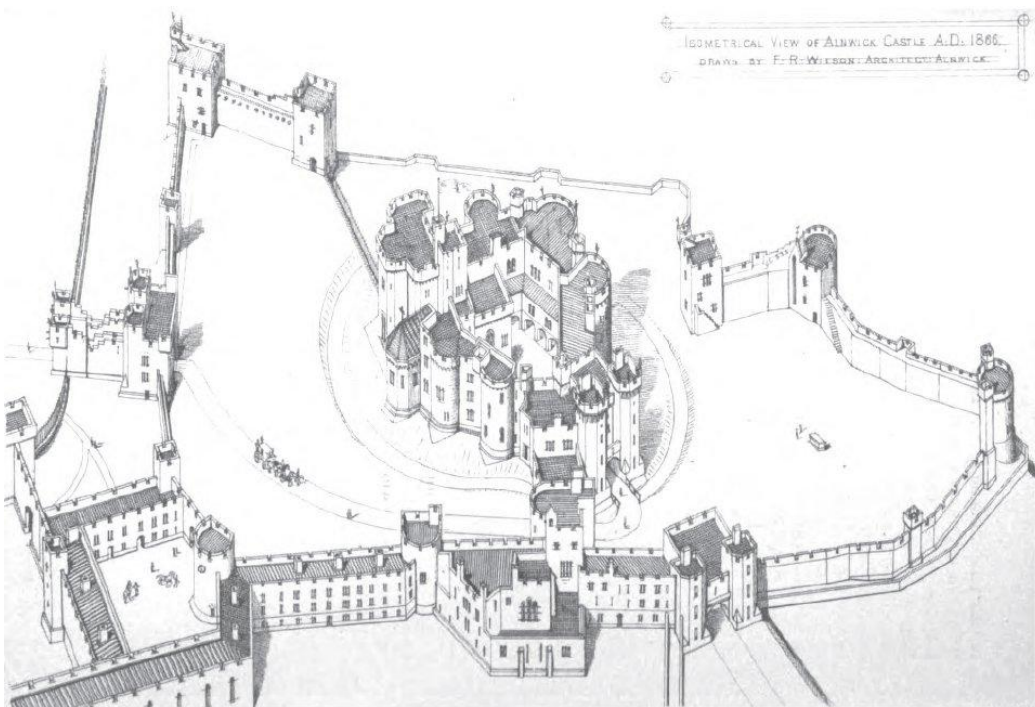
ALNWICK CASTLE!
