4) There are lots of games to choose from to begin to learn the words, and children can choose any of these and play them as many times as they like. However, to ensure that children have learned the words, we ask that they complete **two online tests each week**. Click on 'Practice / Test' then 'Begin Test'. You will be asked if you want the sentences read out loud. Make sure that the test is completed before closing the window or all progress will be lost and the fact that your child has done a test will not be saved and will not count towards the two online tests a week.



5) If you want a list of the spellings your children are learning in a given week, scroll down to the bottom of the game page and click 'Printables'. You will then be given a choice of how you want the list to look.
